# 1 Data Protection Policy

YLJC collects data for the purpose of identifying members, associates and friends.

This is the data you provide on your membership application form and other data you subsequently provide us.

We define this data as sensitive on the grounds of religious affiliation. We only hold data you supply to us and do not request data from any other source.

This data is held in a secure database and only used in furtherance of our aims as a Liberal Jewish community – namely being able to identify you and to communicate with you from time to time. Only information that we are required to send as part of our affiliation requirements is shared with Liberal Judaism.

We do not share, rent, hire or disperse your data to any other third party, unless required to do so by law.

You may ask for a copy of any data we hold by making a request to the Chair. Should you cease to be a member we will hold your data for a period of one year, after which it will be deleted unless you give us permission to continue to hold it.
